These songs weren't written to be polite.

They came out of watching lines get crossed in real time - laws bent, people disappeared, cruelty dressed up as policy, and silence sold as virtue.

I didn't set out to write protest songs. I wrote what I couldn't swallow. What I couldn't ignore. What I didn't want to explain away to my kids or grandkids someday.

This book isn't a sermon and it isn't a brand exercise. It's a record of what it felt like to be paying attention.

Some of these songs are meant to be sung together. Some are meant to sit heavy. All of them are meant to remind us that power doesn't come from crowns, offices, or men who demand obedience.

It comes from us, the people, who refuse to disappear.

If you're reading this, you're part of that!

These songs were written out of love, not anger.

Love for my children, their spouses and partners, and for my grandchildren – **Josh, Sadie, and William (Liam)** - who deserve to inherit an explainable country, not a cautionary tale.

I grew up in the long shadow of World War II and the Cold War. I was raised by a generation that understood, firsthand, what happens when authoritarianism goes unchallenged and when people convince themselves that “it can’t happen here.” I was taught that freedom isn’t permanent, that democracy isn’t self-sustaining, and that complacency is how republics die.

I hoped things would have improved by now. In many ways, they did. And then we stopped paying attention.

Generations grew comfortable. We treated democracy like an heirloom instead of a responsibility. We mistook stability for inevitability. We forgot that **freedom isn’t free!**

Democracy only survives if it is defended - every day, by ordinary people, in ordinary ways, and sometimes at extraordinary cost. History is clear on that point. The price of defending it is always high. The price of failing to defend it is higher.

These songs are my way of refusing to be silent while an authoritarian, fascist movement tries to take root in this country. They are my attempt to push back, to bear witness, and to leave behind proof that some of us saw what was happening and chose to stand up anyway.

If my grandchildren ever ask what I did when democracy was under threat, this is part of the answer. This song book is dedicated to them - and to anyone who still believes that a better country is possible, but only if we are willing to fight for it!
